Campsite Rules and Regulations

TT2017

General Information

Welcome to Union Mills Football Club TT2017 Campsite. We hope you enjoy your stay with us. If you need any assistance please contact a campsite administrator, or a club member in the Kitchen or Bar.

Opening Times

The campsite is open from 14h00 on Friday May 26 to 18h00 on Sunday 11 June. Toilet and shower facilities are open 24 hours a day during this period. Bar and kitchen facilities will be open as advertised.

Arrival

Please pitch your tent upon arrival. The campsite administrator will visit you to provide any advice or guidance required and collect payment where necessary. Be sure to check the site thoroughly for glass, sharp objects, branches that could fall or are hung low. Tents should be pitched at least 6 metres apart.

Facilities

Bar and catering facilities, showers and toilets are in the clubhouse.

Water

Water taps are situated in the clubhouse and toilet and shower areas. A standpipe is located in the car park.

Toilets/Showers

Toilets and showers are available 24 hours a day in the clubhouse. Please note that these operate on a septic tank basis so we will be grateful if no litter, cigarette ends or other incompatible materials are placed in the toilets.

Parking

Please be mindful of other campers when parking. No vehicles will be permitted onto the main football field.

Juniors/Children

Keep the campsite clear of any hazards to children. Keep sharp knives out of reach and especially watch the pot handles when cooking. Be careful of children climbing on lawn chairs. These chairs turn over backwards very easily. Children are allowed into the bar area but it is prohibited to sell to or purchase alcohol on behalf of persons under 18 years of age.

Campsite Etiquette

Please show consideration for other residents of the campsite by not causing noise, playing radios/music too loudly, etc. Don't walk through anyone else's site. Please dispose of all rubbish, litter etc in the bins provided. If a visitor does not show consideration, the Club reserves the right to cancel their booking at which point they will have to immediately leave the campsite. No refund of campsite fees will be made.

Vehicle Movement

There is a speed limit of 5 mph within the club grounds. Please do not exceed this limit. Please keep to the designated vehicle areas.

Departure

When departing the campsite please exercise caution and keep to the drive and car park area. Please ensure that all litter is disposed of in the bins provided. Please use the various recycling bins where possible.

Hygiene

All campers should be aware of the need to follow safety rules and codes whilst in camp. Many diseases and illness can be contracted if proper hygiene rules are not applied. Many can be contracted through open wounds. It is important that footwear is always worn around the site.

Petrol/Diesel Generators

For reasons of noise and for health and safety these are not allowed on the site.

Liability

The Club accepts no liability for death, personal injury, damage to property or other loss, save for that directly caused by the negligence of the club, its servants or agents.

Emergency Services

A first aid kit is available in the kitchen, or in the bar area. Please ask a Club member for assistance.

The hospital is located 400 metres away. This has a 24 hour A&E facility. In case of emergency dial 999 and ask for an ambulance. The location is Union Mills Football Club, Garey Moar, Ballaoates Road, Braddan.

Tents

- Never use candles in or near a tent. Torches are much safer.
- Keep matches and lighters out of the reach of children.
- Flammable liquids should not be brought onto the campsite.
- Oil burning appliances shouldn't be used in or around tents.
- Keep cooking appliances away from walls and the roof and where they can easily be knocked over.
- Cooking appliances should not be used in small tents.
- Don't smoke inside tents.
- Have an escape plan, and be prepared to cut your way out of the tent if there is a fire.
- Make sure everyone knows how to put out a clothing fire - stop, drop and roll.

IN CASE OF FIRE

Fire points with extinguishers and fire buckets are located around the campsite and at the clubhouse. Additionally fire extinguishers are available in the clubhouse.

REMEMBER

- ◆ NEVER turn your back on a fire.
- ◆ If the fire is large, DO NOT try to put it out yourself. Call 999 and move everyone to safety. Extinguishers were designed for incipient (beginning phase) fires, not those well established.
- ◆ Most importantly, most fires are avoidable and the majority are started by poor housekeeping.
